#### How Can You Live? THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

(God's Law, continued)

#### **The Eighth Commandment**

You shall not give **false testimony** against your neighbor.

What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

#### **The Ninth Commandment**

You shall not **covet** your neighbor's house. *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

#### **The Tenth Commandment**

You shall not **covet** your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

Close of the Commandments (Exodus 20:5f)

What does God say about all these commandments? He says: "I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, **punishing** the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me, but **showing love** to a thousand generations of those who love Me and keep My commandments"

What does this mean? God threatens to punish all who break these commandments. Therefore, we should fear His wrath and not do anything against them. But he promises grace (free forgiveness!) and every blessing to all who keep these commandments. Therefore, we should also love and trust in Him and gladly do what he commands.

Find the Ten Commandments at **Exodus 20** and **Deuteronomy 5**. Q & A from the "**Small Catechism**." Written by the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther in 1529, the little book is treasured still by the world's 84 million Lutherans for clearly opening the Bible's truth and celebrating the heart of the Christian faith. Translation by Concordia Publishing House, St. Louis ©1992.

### We Remember Eileen

Eileen Audrey Zeugin, age 95, passed away on September 1, 2024. Even now as she awaits the day of bodily resurrection, Eileen's spirit rejoices with her Savior in paradise. She was ready to reunite with her two loved boys Craig and Kurt. Eileen was a beloved mother, wife, grandmother, and great-grandmother to her family.

Eileen was born on June 19, 1929, in Affton, Missouri, where she married Vernon and raised her three children. She followed her mother and father to Sarasota, Florida in 1967. She worked briefly as a bank clerk but soon became the primary caregiver for her husband with Alzheimer's and later her mother in their final years. Eileen loved to bowl (named bowler of the year once), crochet

hats for premature babies, worship with her church family at Concordia Sarasota Lutheran Church, and support her kids and grandchildren with their life successes. Her family was her passion throughout her years. We would be remiss if we didn't also mention the immense joy her puppy Ebie brought her in the last decade of her life.



Eileen is survived by her daughter Janice Yocum, her daughter-in-law, Dawn Zeugin, and her grandchildren: Tim

Yocum (Michelle), Travis Zeugin (Amy), Jessica Riotti (Steven), and Jenna Klimovich (Greg). Her great-grandchildren: Austin and Morgan; Kaina and Annlee; Alessia, Jordan and Dominic; and Elijah, Macklin and Adelina. She is predeceased by her husband Vernon, and sons Craig and Kurt. Her memory will be cherished by all who knew her.

Many thanks to the excellent care of Sue Jennings who spent the last years with Eileen. She was truly more than a caregiver; she was exceptionally patient and devoted to Eileen. In addition to the care from her daughter, the support from Tidewell Hospice was appreciated.

Eileen (nee Ryan) was newborn baptized in July 1927. She and Vernon followed Jesus first in Affton (St. Louis) Missouri. Then they were leaders at Mt. Tabor Lutheran Church, a mission in Manchester Missouri. In our Concordia family, for years she helped Vern make his elder calls to the homebound and hospitalized, often delivering cassette tapes of Concordia's worship. Until 1986, Eileen served as our Greeter Coordinator. She was welcoming! Eilleen took to heart Jesus' forgiveness, rejoiced to hear of the resurrection and to receive Jesus' sacramental Body and Blood, prayed with her pastor and elders, and spoke of her faith. Her motto: "The Lord says: Trust in Me and do not worry."






